YOU ARE A MULTI-HYPHENATE CREATIVE ENTREPRENEUR WITH COMPLEMENTARY BRANDS. GIVEN THAT YOUR FOCUS HAS PRIMARILY SHIFTED TO WRITING, BUT YOU ARE STILL NOTED FOR YOUR ENERGY IN THE KITCHEN, WHERE ARE YOU ON YOUR JOURNEY REGARDING SEPARATING OR BRINGING TOGETHER THE DUALITY OF YOUR OFFERS? .

This is such a thoughtful question and comes at a great time. Since I started writing my first book way back in 2017 (or, more realistically, since I was about ten years old), I've been able to visualize myself as a writer. It wasn't until my book came out in late 2020 that I realized that being a self-published author is a lot like being an entrepreneur that I saw myself doing it as a career. At the time, COVID had really changed how my catering company operated, and I was starting to see some serious benefits of working from home and switching careers. As of September 2022, Yoda's Kitchen has been permanently closed so I can pursue writing full-time. This was an easy decision... and also a painful one. But I'm certain it was the right one!

YOUR VULNERABILITY IN YOUR WRITING HAS BECOME YOUR CALLING CARD. AS SOMEONE WITH A LOT OF AQUARIAN ENERGY, HOW DO YOU BALANCE YOUR INDIVIDUALITY WITH THAT INNATE DESIRE TO CONNECT AND BUILD COMMUNITY?

Another amazing question! This is what I consider to be “my work” right now. I am constantly balancing these big bursts of vulnerability with a vulnerability hangover! One thing that has really helped me is to think of my writing as a beautiful act of service to others. My words are something only I can offer, and every time I share from my heart (the good, the bad, and the ugly), I am connected to someone who needs those exact words. When I have a vulnerability hangover, I try to remember that.

REMOVE THE EGO, BECOME A VESSEL — IT'S MY LIFE'S WORK.


WHAT IS YOUR WRITING PROCESS LIKE?

I have always been a very avid writer and journaler. From the age of 10, I started writing about my day. It wasn't every single day, and there was never a rhyme or reason to it, but I filled journal after journal. (I have them all, and let me tell you, ten-year-old Yoda was pretty funny!!) When I got more serious about writing my book in 2017, I had to set actual time aside, and after a few months of trying different practices, I found out that I am definitely someone who is most productive in the morning. So my current writing process is to set aside at least 2 hours every morning for non-work-related writing. I usually spend half of that time journaling and the other half writing my newsletter or poetry. The words non-work related are key there!

HOW DO BOTH OF YOUR PRIMARY CREATIVE OUTLETS HELP YOU NOT ONLY TO HEAL BUT TO EVOLVE?

It's pretty cool looking back on my culinary career through photographs of my plates and old menus I designed. It's like I can see who I was at that time. At 20, I was really bold. Everything was spicy. I used a lot of big, contrasting flavors. By the time I was 30, my plates were more refined. Less cluttered. I still had a lot to say but found the content in the empty space of a plate. Writing is kind of the same journey. When I'm going through something, I freehand journal about it for hours sometimes. When I have some clarity (and often time and distance) from it, I refine it into a more concise piece. I learned it first with food on a plate and now with words on a page. I'm learning how less is more.



WHAT ATMOSPHERES WOULD YOU LIKE TO WORK WITHIN?

I hope to keep my business primarily an online business — working with clients worldwide from the comfort of my gorgeous home office. It is where I feel safest and most creative.

If I do launch something to do with recovery networks, I hope to work in recovery centers, especially women's shelters.

I also want to put it out there that I am open to any collaborations with cute coffee shops if anyone reading has an adorable space and needs a host for an Open Mic!

WHAT IS YOUR PROCESS LIKE WHEN WORKING WITH CLIENTS, AND HOW DO YOU BEST OPERATE?

As expected, I'm pretty methodical when working with a client. I have created an Intentional Productivity framework which I use with my clients. Depending on their needs, we do an intake call where we devise an action plan and take it from there.

I work best according to a plan or schedule myself because this allows me to plan ahead and make sure I spend my time according to my priorities.

HOW DO YOU ENVISION YOUR BUSINESS GROWING IN THE COMING YEARS?

Now that I am able to dedicate all my working hours to Doula of Words, I see BIG things. I also have about 5 or 6 books of my own in the incubator. So I am eager to get to work on those and build my own author brand as well! My main goal for this upcoming year is to grow the coaching side of my business — I want to guide first-time authors as they birth their books into the world.

One thing I am really excited about in the coming years is to see how my work as a writing coach and workshop facilitator can blend with my other worlds — particularly as an addict in recovery. I'd really love to find a way to offer writing spaces to people in recovery centers.

ANY LAST GOLDEN NUGGETS OF WISDOM YOU CAN SHARE WITH US?

When I work with clients, there are five main things I coach people through:

1. Writing/finishing their manuscript
2. Editing
3. Formatting
4. Publishing
5. Marketing

All of these aspects are equally important.

However, the final three steps can be done in a few weeks or months — it's taking the first step that really scares people. What I tell people who want to write, whether they're working on a book deal, a memoir, a novel, or a single poem, is that to be a better writer, you have to write. Expose yourself to words constantly. Read. Read more. Write—every day. You are already a writer, and it's just getting your story down on the page that is the hard part.

FOLLOW-UP, WHAT IS YOUR DREAM PROJECT? WE'LL MANIFEST IT RIGHT NOW.

I am currently writing my dream project, which is something so raw and vulnerable; I kind of can't believe I am pursuing it! I can't say much about it yet, but this is the project that will change my whole life as I know it!!

CHARACTERISTICS

Those with an Aquarius (Air) Midheaven are sometimes innovative, brilliant thinkers. They do their best work alone but must not forget to collaborate and learn the value of another's perspective now and then.

PRODUCTIVITY TIPS

- When you are prone to working alone, schedule some social moments in your calendar to (re)connect with your peers, co-workers or other human beings that might have a different opinion or view than you have.

FLEX YOUR MIND

Don't let the prefix -aqua fool you. Aquarius is an air sign and the final air sign in the Zodiac. Before you continue reading this, take a moment to connect with the air element. Step outside if you can, even if it's cold. Dare I suggest you step out in a t-shirt, just for a moment, and feel the chill in the air? Feel the gooseflesh rise on your arms—the clicking and clacking of your teeth. See your breath turn to fog in front of you. Is there a breeze, or does the cold hang in the air like invisible ice particles? Or are you in the Southern hemisphere, where it's now the peak of summer? Feel the heat in the air, the way it pulls salt water from your pores. Does the breeze provide relief from the cold? Or does the heat hang heavy in the air, weighing you down?

Okay, you can go back inside now.

When we think of airy people, we think ungrounded and a little too eccentric and unreliable for comfort. We lay negative judgments and associations upon it. But air, as an element, is as much a life force as water. Without it, we perish. In medicine, it's often said that everyone ultimately dies of some form of shock. When the body is in shock, it is unable to adequately perfuse (i.e., transport blood throughout the body.) It's our blood that carries oxygen to each of our organs and allows us to function. When a child is born, we first look for the cry of new life. That scream requires your first breath in the living world. In the Zodiac, the air is the element of communication and change. It shows up in someone's way with words, intellect, and a likely habit of intellectualizing their emotions.

Like any other element, we cannot do without it.

BALANCING YOUR AIR

The negative connotations associated with the air element aren't entirely unfounded. They typically come about when someone has too much air throwing an imbalance in their system. To identify it in yourself, you may feel literally ungrounded or scattered. You may feel like you're having trouble focusing on anything and are unable to finish a project before the next breeze of inspiration sweeps you away. On the other side, when your air is lacking, you may feel dull, uninspired or unmotivated, stuck, and generally lack the luster of life you so enjoy.

Here are a few tips for balancing your air:

1. Meet flexibility and freedom with structure. Air needs room to move (literally and figuratively), but it also requires a container to give it some shape. Consider how you can optimize your schedule in a way that allows for both structure and spontaneity.
2. Move your body. Make sure you get regular movement in your day. Whether that's a run or long walk, a yoga class or a good lift session, or something else altogether - what's important is your move every day in a way that you enjoy and makes your body feel good. It doesn't have to be strenuous - just enough to ensure your feet still feel grounded on the earth.

WATER BEARER BREAKFAST

Ingredients:

For the granola:

- 1 cup rolled oats
- $\frac{1}{4}$ cup pumpkin seeds
- $\frac{1}{4}$ cup chopped walnuts or pecans
- 2 tbsp maple syrup
- $\frac{1}{2}$ tsp cinnamon
- $\frac{1}{2}$ tsp salt

- $\frac{3}{4}$ cup plain Greek yogurt
- 4 juicy dates

- $\frac{1}{4}$ cup pomegranate seeds
- 2 fresh (or dried) figs
- $\frac{1}{4}$ cup blueberries

- 2 tbsp slivered almonds
- 1 tsp whole chia seeds
- 2 tbsp honey or maple syrup
- optional: 1 scoop nut butter

METHOD:

- 1.) Like any Aquarian, start planning the night before. Preheat the oven to 325 and gather all ingredients for the granola. Toss them in a large bowl and pour onto a cookie sheet lined with parchment paper.
- 2.) Bake at 325F for 15 minutes, stir contents of the pan and bake for another 10 minutes. Remove from heat and once cooled, place this mix in an airtight jar.
- 3.) The next morning, fill a bowl with yogurt, and arrange all other toppings however you wish. Pour them on randomly, or make the bowl your canvas. Drizzle the bowl with honey or syrup and top the entire thing with a heart scoop of your homemade granola.
- 4.) Remind yourself to savour every single bite, no matter how messy.


